



## Marine Notice No. 33 of 2023

*Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers*

### Kinsale Head and Seven Heads Gas Fields - Debris Clearance Celtic Sea

#### 1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that PSE Kinsale Energy Limited will be carrying out debris clearance activities commencing on **1 June 2023**. The debris clearance start date and the estimated duration of **25 days** are subject to weather and operational constraints. Details are provided below.

#### 2. Location of Activity

The operations will take place at locations of previously decommissioned infrastructure, as shown in the Location Map available at Appendix 1 and as detailed in the table below.

### 3. Details of the Debris Clearance Vessel

The work will be conducted by a Construction Support Vessel the “**Dina Star**” (**Call Sign: LDJG3**) These works will involve the use of subsea construction equipment at the locations listed above. The vessel will display appropriate lights and signals. The vessel will operate during day and night hours. All vessels, particularly those engaged in fishing, are requested to give the “**Dina Star**” a wide berth during the operations and keep a sharp lookout in the relevant areas.
