



NOTICE TO MARINERS

Fishing vessel convoy as part of awareness campaign

This notice should be read in conjunction with:

- Media Outlets / Updates

Mariners are advised that a large number of fishing vessels are intending to visit Cork Harbour as part of a campaign to raise awareness over fishing matters. This will occur on or about the 26th of May 2021.

Current plans indicate that approximately 50 fishing vessels will congregate near the harbour entrance adjacent to Roches Point, before travelling in convoy upriver and following the navigation channel to Cork city. The intention is to congregate at approximately 0700 hrs and to berth in the city at approximately 0900 hrs.

These fishing vessels will berth at the following berths:

Primary Berths: Penrose Quay and Albert Quay as primary berths

Contingency berths: South Deep Water Quay, Horgans Quay and the North Jetties.

Mariners are advised that while all channels and berths will remain open for use during the convoy, there will be heavy traffic on the river which may cause minor delays.

Mariners are further advised to pass by the convoy with as wide a margin as possible and to maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 for any further updates.
