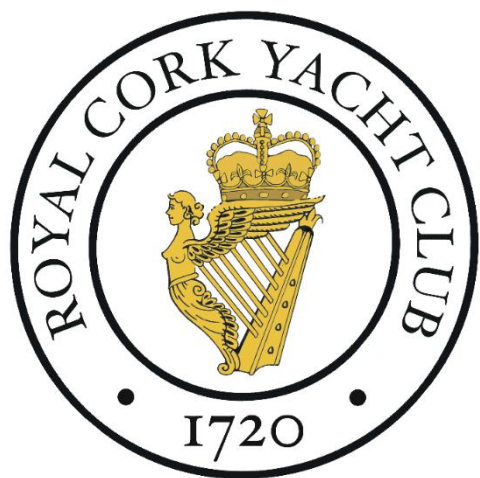

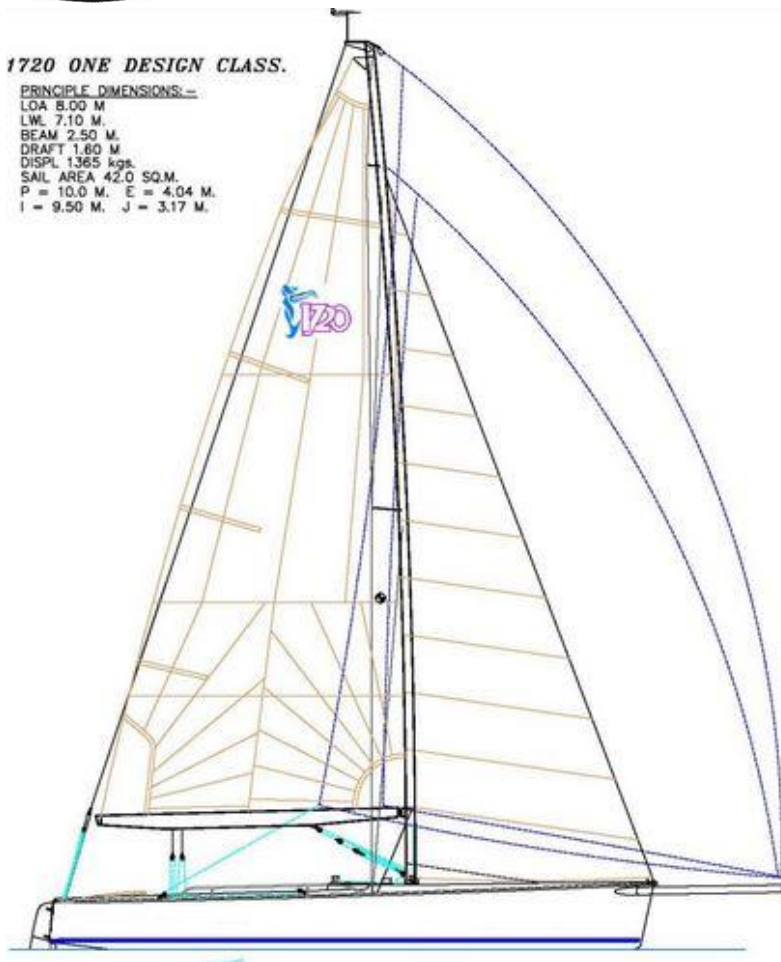

## 1 RULES

### 1.1

This event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (“RRS”) 2013 - 2016.

### 1.2

The Irish Sailing Association prescriptions will apply.

### 1.3

The current 1720 Class rules will apply.

### 1.4

Where there is a conflict with the Notice of Race, the sailing instructions shall prevail except that neither shall change nor alter a class rule.

## 2 ADVERTISING

### 2.1

Advertising for the regatta shall follow RRS 80. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

### 2.2

The OA reserves the right to refuse entry to the event if there is, in its opinion, a conflict of interest between a competitor’s sponsor and the event sponsor.

### 2.3

Any boat considering accepting or entering with sponsorship that might be affected by this rule is advised to contact the OA before entering.

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## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

### 3.1

Boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and return via email, fax or post to:

By August 28<sup>th</sup> 2015, Entries received after August 28<sup>th</sup> will be deemed as late entries.

### 3.2

Late entries will be accepted up to and including September 02<sup>nd</sup> 2015 at the discretion of the OA and may be subject to a late entry fee of €30.

### 3.3

The Entry Fee for this event is set at €160 and is non refundable

### 3.4 Launching

Craning and berthing at the event is included in the entry fee. The crane will be available from 1000 to 2100 on Wednesday 02<sup>nd</sup>. Launching on Thursday 03<sup>rd</sup> will be available from 8.30 but only by appointment with the race office. Boat lift out is available on Saturday after racing.

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## 4 Class Rules

### 4.1

Measurement/Inspection: Boats and sailors may be subject to scrutiny before or after any race at the discretion of the Race Committee, the Event Measurer. An Event Measurer may inspect any boat at any time, and competitors are requested to comply, as far as is reasonable and practical, with the Event Measurer's requests. Failure to do so may result in the protest of that boat by the Event Measurer and/or the Race Committee. Boats evidenced at the time of inspection to not comply with Class Rules will be liable to protest by the Event Measurer and/or the Race Committee.

### 4.2

Safety - All boats shall comply with the prescriptions set out in the Class Rules. Boats shall be equipped with a marine VHF radio, the primary purpose of which is to monitor the Race Committee unless otherwise dictated by Class Rules. The channel used will be noted in the sailing instructions.

### 4.3

All boats shall comply with the prescriptions set out in the current Class Rules and/or the Notice of Race and/or Sailing Instructions, from the time of the first warning signal of the first race until returning alongside the marina following the final race of the series.

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## 5 SCHEDULE

### 5.1

Competitors may register at Royal Cork Yacht Club Race Office from 1700 to 2100hrs on Wednesday 02<sup>nd</sup> and from 0830 to 0900 on Thursday 03<sup>rd</sup>

Crew weighing will take place during the same periods as registration and complete crews should be presented at one time.

To comply with registration requirements, competitors must ensure the following:

- The signed entry form has been submitted in full and the entry fee is fully paid.
- Emergency contact names and telephone numbers are provided.
- Completion of safety checks as requested.

### 5.2

It is proposed to sail nine races. A minimum of three races must be sailed to constitute a series.

#### Proposed Schedule of Races:

Thursday 03<sup>rd</sup> of September 2015: Up to four races

Friday 04<sup>th</sup> of September 2015: Up to four races

Saturday 05<sup>th</sup> of September 2015: Remaining races to complete series of nine races. No race will be started after 1500 Saturday 05<sup>th</sup> of September 2015, except for postponements, general recalls and abandonment of a race where the warning signal was made before 1500.

#### Regatta Briefing:

0900 Thursday 03<sup>rd</sup> of September 2015

#### Warning Signals:

First warning signal for each days racing will be 10.55, the Schedule of all subsequent races will be as directed in the Sailing Instructions.

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## 6 MEASUREMENTS

### 6.1

Boats will comply with current class rules and may be measured during the event.

## 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after August 20<sup>th</sup> 2015 from the Race Office and will be posted online [www.royalcork.com](http://www.royalcork.com)

## 8 VENUE

### 8.1.

Racing will take place in Cork Harbour and its surrounding waters. Refer to Admiralty charts 1777 and 1765.

## 10 COURSES

### 10.1

The course may be a single Windward/Leeward layout with exact details specified in the sailing instructions. Target race time will be 50 mins, but will be at the sole discretion of the Race Committee.

## 11 SCORING

### 11.1

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A4 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with her worst score/s discarded according to the table below. Rule A4 is amended to accommodate rule A5 and will be used even when a series is a Regatta. A minimum of three races will constitute a series. Discards applied based on races sailed

5 or more races sailed 1 discard

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 12 BERTHING

Designated Dinghy Park Spaces will be provided to competitors for the duration of the regatta. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in Royal Cork Yacht Club's Dinghy Park at all times when ashore. While in the water temporary marina berths will be provided for all competing boats.

#### 14 PRIZES

The presentation of prizes will take place as soon as possible following racing on Saturday 05<sup>th</sup> of September 2015.

#### 15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

The Safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat. He/She must ensure that the boat and her crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the Regatta. Neither the establishment of the required safety regulations nor the inspection of any boat in any way limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for their crew, boat and the management thereof.

#### 16 INSURANCE

It is the duty of each boat owner to have his boat adequately insured against any risk, including civil responsibility to third parties and to ensure that such insurance remains valid for the entirety of the event. All owners / competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owners / competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry

#### 17 MEDIA WAIVER

Competitors give their consent to Royal Cork Yacht Club, its sponsors, and the organising authority to use their name, comments, photograph and likeness in order to promote the Event

#### 17 FACILITIES

Competitors are granted temporary membership of Royal Cork Yacht Club from Wednesday 02<sup>nd</sup> September 2015 to Sunday 06<sup>th</sup> of September 2015, subject only to the provisions of the Club Rules for withdrawing or withholding such membership. All competitors are invited to avail of the facilities of the Club during the event.

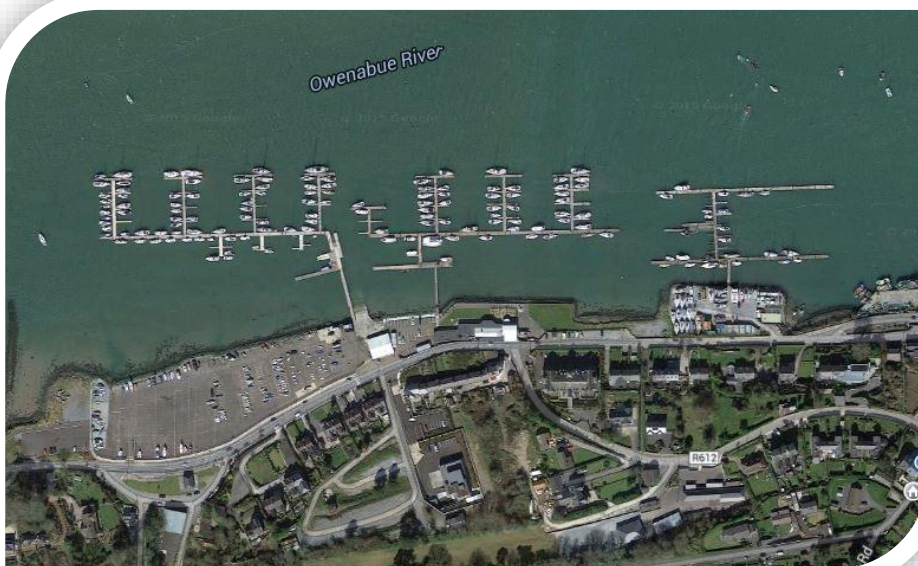
