Notice of Race

1. Venue

The Royal Alfred Yacht Club takes pleasure in inviting you to compete in the Bloomsday Regatta which will be held on Saturday June 15th 2013 under the Burgee of the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, in association with the Dun Laoghaire waterfront Yacht Clubs. The host club is the Royal Irish Yacht Club where the Race Office will be situated.

2. Rules.

This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the competing class rules.

3. Classes

The Regatta will be held for the following classes. Cruiser Classes 0,1,2,3a and 3b & White Sails, Laser SB20, Dragon, Sigma 33, Beneteau 31.7, Beneteau 21, Puppeteer, Ruffian, Glen, Shipman 23, Flying 15, Squib, Mermaid, Fireball, 420, IDRA 14, Laser 1, Radial, Water Wags and Portsmouth Yardstick.

4. Category.

ISAF Regulation 20 will apply. Class rules limiting the display of advertising will apply.

5. Entries.

Boats shall enter online www.rayc.ie or using the entry form below by Thursday 13th June. The Entry fee is as per the entry form. Written entries should be mailed to the Secretary, Royal Alfred Yacht Club, PO Box 7512, Dun Laoghaire, Co Dublin. Late entries will be charged €10 additional at the discretion of the OA. All competitors are granted temporary membership of the RAYC for the duration of the Regatta.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be e-mailed to those who entered online. Copies of the Sailing Instructions may be left in the Yacht Club designated on the entry form and will be available in the Race Office at the Royal Irish Yacht Club.

8. Scoring

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. Penalties

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for Course B only.

10. Insurance

Each Boat's owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons. Boats or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain sufficient 3rd party insurance cover. All Owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

11. Liability

No responsibility shall be accepted by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, or any of the associated yacht clubs, their directors, officers, members servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the event, for any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature, however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Regatta

12. Responsibility

The safety of the Boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge whose obligation it is to ensure that the Boat is fully sound, seaworthy and is manned by an experienced crew with all the required safety gear. Neither this Notice of Race nor the Sailing Instructions nor any action by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club and its Organising Committee in any way limits the responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge. Attention is drawn to RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rules.

13. Prizes

First, second and third prizes will be presented for each class subject to the number of entries received and is at the discretion of the Race Committee. These will be presented at the Royal Irish Yacht Club 15th June c1700
Royal Alfred Trophies will be presented to Royal Alfred Members at the RAYC Annual Dinner on Friday 22nd November in the National Yacht Club.

They will also be available at the Royal Irish Yacht Club race office on 15th June from 18.00 to 20.00 and on 15th June from 09.30 to 10.30.
